# Pastor's Letter

March 2, 2025—8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Church Family,

In our Gospel reading for today Jesus says, "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit? No disciple is superior to the teacher; but when fully trained, every disciple will be like his teacher." Choosing the right guide or the right teacher is essential to getting where we want to go or learning how to get through life.

Our guide and our teacher is Christ. In him we have the perfect example of what a full human life looks like. He showed us that the way to get the most out of life is to give ourselves away in love and the way to be truly free is to do the will of the Father. That's what his own life was all about.

We know that the best leaders and teachers are the ones who lead by example and that's just what Jesus did. We see in Scripture how Jesus stayed close to the Father in prayer, helped those in need through miracles of healing, and offered his life as a sacrifice for the world. His life is the template for every Christian. We may never achieve the perfection of Christ but he has given us the goal to strive for.

This week we begin the season of Lent. God invites the church to renew our efforts to pattern our life after that of Jesus by our Lenten disciplines of prayer, which builds up our personal relationship with him, fasting and other penances, by which we sacrifice our comfort as a sign of our sorrow for our sins and in recognition of our dependence on God alone, and almsgiving, through which we stand together with those in need. We do these things because Jesus did them. He prayed constantly. He gave his life on the cross as a penance, not for his own sins, but for ours. He showed compassion to all. If we follow him in these practices, we shall also follow him into eternal life. With Jesus as our guide and teacher, may this Lent bring us closer to the joy of the resurrection.

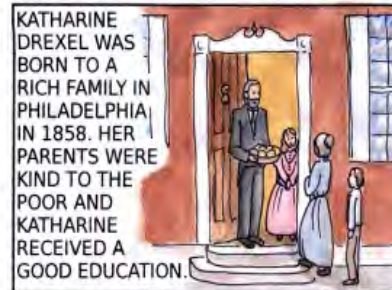
